1. FAITH ALIVE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL: Build a children's hospital that will treat under-resourced kids in Jos, Nigeria completely for free.



2. AIM CAMBODIA: Aim swat raid in Takeo, Cambodia and put on a conference for 60 pastors.

3. KUWASHA: Education and Healthcare for kids in Uganda, Africa.

4. A21 (CHRISTINE CAINE): Operates prevention programs, rescues victims of human trafficking, and prosecutes traffickers globally.

5. HEART: Open new center for women who have AIDS/HIV, for holistic counseling and wellbeing. Build-out of new counseling center.

6. INDIA MINISTRY: Support the training of pastors to plant 10 churches.

7. 3RD PERSON (JORDAN): Provides support for Syrian & Iraqi children refugees with food, education, and providing Bibles.

8. WORLD VISION WATER PROJECT: Builds and maintains clean water systems in rural communities lacking access to safe drinking water.

9. GOOD CAUSE SACRAMENTO: Rehab and reentry home for former inmates.

10. SIMPLY PEOPLE / ENDLESS RIPPLES: Restoring wells, providing microloans for women, and helping families thrive in unreached places.

11. SLAVE 2 NOTHING: Fighting against human trafficking & substance abuse in the U.S. and around the world.

12. JVI: Fund the rescue of victims, provide legal help, aftercare and partnered with local agencies to restore freedom and prevent exploitation.

13. CAMP UKRAINE: Hosting, caring for, and providing support for children from Ukraine who have lost a parent in the war.

14. HIS LITTLE FEET: Providing education and a new community center in Rwanda.



15. CHOSEN TV: Support the work to translate the Chosen into languages for people to hear the gospel around the world.

16. GOD BEHIND BARS: Launch Bayside campuses in prisons.

17. FOOD DRIVES FOR LOCAL FOOD BANKS: Collects and distributes thousands of pounds of food to local families in need.

25. EXPAND CELEBRATE RECOVERY: Expand our recovery ministry to reach the people in our community.

26. CONVOY OF HOPE (DISASTER RELIEF, FOOD BANK, ONE DAY TO FEED THE WORLD): Responds worldwide to natural disasters with food, water, and rebuilding assistance.

27. MEXICO: Scholarship teenagers to go serve and build homes for the people of Mexico.

28. MILITARY AND VETERAN SERVICES: Supporting APU Military veterans and their families.

29. ALTERNATIVE PREGNANCY CENTER: Provides pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, parenting classes, and support for women choosing life.

30. CESAR CHAVEZ LANGUAGE ACADEMY: Two way immersion program for students learning English in Santa Rosa

31. GIGI'S PLAYHOUSE: Provides programming and support for individuals with Down Syndrome.

32. ALKARE MEXICO/AFRICA: A faith-based organization supporting orphanages by strengthening them in body (nutrition), mind (education), and soul (discipleship).

33. CITY TO CITY URBAN CHURCH PLANTING: Church planting in urban areas.

34. SIERRA PREGNANCY CENTER: Offers pregnancy counseling, practical resources, and ongoing support for mothers and families.

35. BREAKAWAY (INDIA): Providing Breakaway Kids Camps for kids in India, teaching faith and life skills.

36. THE PERSECUTED CHURCH: Provides aid, Bibles, and training to Christians living under persecution.

37. MENTAL HEALTH HELP FOR YOUTH: Funds counseling, workshops, and resources for students facing anxiety and depression.

38. CHURCH PLANT UKRAINE: Supports pastors and local believers planting new churches throughout war-torn regions.

39. FAITH ALIVE BAYSIDE CHURCH PLANT: Launching a Bayside campus in Jos, Nigeria in partnership with Faith Alive.

40. HEALTHBRIDGE GLOBAL: Sends volunteer medical teams to provide surgery, training, and healthcare around the world.

41. YOUNGLIFE: Funding summer camps in eastern Europe to introduce young people to Jesus Christ and help them grow in their faith.

42. CHANGING LIVES TOGETHER "MEDICAL": Provide medical equipment and an ambulance for a remote hospital in Ghana.

43. JAKE'S JOURNEY HOME: Assisting unhoused veterans and community members with supportive services.

44. SWEET DREAMS FOUNDATION: Remodeling kid's bedrooms that are facing life threatening illnesses.

45. POWERHOUSE MINISTRIES: Provide transitional housing for women and children in Folsom.

46. SERVE DAY: Mobilizes thousands of volunteers for one-day community service projects across the region.

47. ACRES OF HOPE: Help provide finances for a childrens building on their property to support the work they do with unhoused women with children.

48. JOSHUA'S HOUSE: Providing hospice for terminally ill unhoused individuals.

49. VOLUNTEERS OF AMERICA: Dedicated to helping unhoused, jobless, aged out foster youth, etc.

50. CITY OF REFUGE: Provide housing and resources for underserved women and children in Sacramento.

51. MOBILIZE LOVE: Provide mobile after school programs and human services to kids in San Francisco.

52. ARAB AMERICAN LEARNING CENTER: Offers English classes, job training, and relationship-building.

53. KEATON'S PLACE: Support families with children that are diagnosed with cancer.

54. RANGER ROAD: Helps veterans reintegrate through adaptive sports, community, and support networks.

55. COMPASSION PLANET: Provide resources for a training center and affordable housing for aged out foster kids.

56. MOUNT HERMON: Providing scholarships for single moms, their children and supporting military families.

57. UNION GOSPEL MISSION: Provide resources to remodel their kitchen, chapel, and dining hall.

58. LAUNCH CAMPUSES: Launch 10 Bayside campuses in California.

59. FOLSOM'S HOPE: Supports vulnerable, low-income, and at-risk children in Folsom, California, through school-based, lunch-buddy mentoring, and after-school programs.

60. ORANGE COUNTY RESCUE MISSION: Provides comprehensive services, including housing, food, counseling, and job training, to help unhoused individuals and families in Orange County.

61. REDWOOD GOSPEL MISSION: Providing comprehensive services to the unhoused, hungry, and addicted in Sonoma and Mendocino Counties.

62. DEFENDING THE CAUSE: Advocates for vulnerable children and equips churches to engage in foster and family care.

63. TWIN LAKES FOOD BANK: Helping fund a new building to serve the hungry.

64. STUDENT COMMUNITY CARES: Fund a food pantry to provide food to unhoused, fostered, and underserved highschool students.

65. THRIVE CONFERENCES: Develop and train over 4,000 leaders to impact their churches.

66. PASTOR COACHING: Support, train, and encourage other pastors and student pastors who are doing ministry alone.

67. OPEN EYES: Help finish a compassion outreach center connected to a vibrant local church in Oaxaca, Mexico.

68. CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP (BOSNIA): Disciples university students and raises up future Christian leaders.

69. ALASKA CHRISTIAN COLLEGE: Educates and trains Native Alaskan students for ministry and community leadership.

70. BAYSIDE GLOBAL PARTNER CONNECTION: Sends Bayside staff on mission trips to connect, encourage & evaluate our global partners.

71. MISSION TO INDIA: Continue to provide resources for children in a remote part of India.

72. EVANGELICAL ALLIANCE MISSION (JAPAN): Partners with local churches to plant and strengthen Christian communities in Japan.

73. THRIVE ROUND TABLES - CUBA & EUROPE: Trains Cuban & European pastors in leadership, discipleship, and church multiplication.

74. FIRST RESPONDER MARRIAGE CONFERENCE: Provide a conference for first responders marriages to support, equip, and encourage them.

75. PLANT CHURCHES IN CHINA: Trains local believers to lead and multiply underground churches in China.

76. STUDENT REACH MINISTRY (MEXICO): Build a worship center/dining hall so teams can come and serve people and churches in Mexico.

77. ARRABON: Provide resources for biblically and rooted spiritual formation for young people.

78. ALKARE MEXICO/AFRICA: A faith-based organization supporting orphanages by strengthening them in body (nutrition), mind (education), and soul (discipleship).

79. IBEROAMERICAN MINISTRIES (IAM): Provide medicine & medical care for displaced Kurdish families in Northern Iraq.

80. 4G NETWORK: Connects and trains pastors in Africa, Asia, and the Americas for church growth and evangelism.
